Paris&Co;'s Urban Lab (2010) and its metropolitan successor QMI (2022) test urban prototypes in real Parisian streets. OECD Cogito (2025) calls it 'Europe's largest urban experimentation program': 75+ prototypes across 10 Greater Paris districts, 100+ startups supported annually.
