Summary

World's first jurisdictional REDD+ system (Acre State Law 2.308/2010), covering 15.4 M ha of Amazon forest; Standard Chartered-CDSA partnership to sell up to 40 million ART/TREES carbon credits (ICVCM-approved), with 72% of revenue flowing to community beneficiaries.
