

ADII's AI-Powered Customs Risk Management — Morocco's Record 2025 Surge in Fraud Detection and Seizures

Summary

Morocco's ADII deployed AI-driven predictive risk analytics with the WCO and Swiss SECO. Its 2025 report ties the tools to a 33% rise in value redressments, doubled drug seizures, and a 450m-dirham false-invoice bust — though no study isolates AI's specific contribution.
