Summary

UNESCO, Ai Movement and Morocco's OCP Foundation run a 3-year, \$500,000 AI programme for African women: 34 women from 11 countries in a 2023 pilot, then 80 women from 28 countries completing a 2024 course and Rabat summer camp, with 15 winning incubation grants.
