ITU, Google.org and will.i.am's I Am Angel Foundation launched a one-year AI-and-robotics pilot across five African countries in September 2025, targeting 20,000 students and 1,000 teachers; Côte d'Ivoire held its teacher training-of-trainers workshop in March 2026.
