Summary

Singapore's AI Singapore and IMDA have run the full-time AI Apprenticeship Programme since 2018: cohorts grew from 13 to 66 apprentices per batch, over 60 industry partners host projects, and AIAP reports at least 70% of recent graduates receive job offers before finishing.
