Summary

British University Vietnam piloted the AI Assessment Scale, a 5-level framework for permitted GenAI use in coursework; the peer-reviewed evaluation reported a 5.9% rise in attainment, a 33.3% rise in module pass rates, and fewer GenAI misconduct cases.
