

AI-Assisted Wealth-Report Screening — Indonesia's KPK Uses Machine Learning to Flag Anomalous Asset Declarations

Summary

Indonesia's KPK piloted AI that flags anomalies in officials' mandatory wealth declarations for manual review. In 2025 it screened about 1,000 of 415,062 required filings - under 0.3% - with KPK's chair citing efficiency gains, though it remains a small early pilot.
