Summary

India's MeitY and NASSCOM's AI Curriculum Taskforce completed a national baseline study of B.Tech Computer Science programmes (May 2026) and recommended a 'triple helix' overhaul raising practical AI exposure from 25–30% to 40–75% and embedding Responsible AI in every semester.
