

AI for All — Greece's Ministry of Interior and Google Scale Generative-AI Training to Tens of Thousands of Public Servants

Summary

Greece's Ministry of Interior and Google trained 85,772 public employees in digital/AI skills from 2023-2025 (35,839 in AI-specific courses in 2024-25 alone); 94% say they will apply the skills and satisfaction topped 89%, under a partnership renewed through December 2026.
