

# AI for Citizens — UNDP and Intel's Digital Ambassador Network Bringing AI Literacy to Rural Lesotho

## Summary

Under a March 2025 UNDP–Intel MoU, Lesotho set up 40 Digital Skills Learning Labs and trained 40 community 'Digital Ambassadors' using low-connectivity, analogue AI-literacy materials to reach citizens beyond the capital.
