UNDP and Intel trained 40 community 'Digital Ambassadors' — teachers, religious leaders and local influencers — to deliver offline, game-based AI literacy sessions across 40 new Digital Skills Learning Labs, reaching low-connectivity rural Lesotho under a March 2025 MoU.
