

AI Generation — UiPath Foundation's free AI-literacy curriculum for Romanian high schools

Summary

UiPath Foundation's open-source AI Generation curriculum piloted with 94 underserved Romanian teens in 2024 (97% said they learned something new, 80% wanted an AI career) and reached 1,665 students via 37 teachers in 2025–26, with rural students outperforming urban peers.
