Summary

Algeria's Ministry of Higher Education used an AI matching algorithm for the first time in 2026 to place 391,018 of 403,119 new baccalaureate holders (97%) into university programmes, with 84.71% receiving one of their top three choices via the orientation-esi.dz platform.
