Nigeria's Federal Ministry of Education and ICEDT Consult signed a ToR on 29-31 July 2026 to scale AI teacher training — piloted in six Federal Unity Colleges, one per geopolitical zone — to about 11,700 teachers nationwide; no quantitative pilot results are published.
