

Aj Ty v IT — Slovakia's Girls-in-IT Nonprofit Adds AI to Its National Coding Curriculum

Summary

Slovak nonprofit Aj Ty v IT has reached 65,000+ girls, women and teachers with IT workshops since 2012; backed by a €200,000+ Google.org grant, it now runs AI curricula, including a hands-on micro:bit AI workshop, in a country where women hold just 9.2% of ICT jobs.
