

# AnySurfer — Belgium's National Digital Accessibility Label

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

## Summary

Since 2001, Belgian nonprofit AnySurfer has audited websites against WCAG and awarded a public accessibility label; as of Sept 2026 it lists 60 labelled sites spanning government, healthcare, transit and NGOs, with WCAG AA mandatory for federal sites.
