

aprendIA — IRC's AI Chatbot Bringing Learning Support to Crisis-Affected Northeast Nigeria

Summary

The International Rescue Committee's aprendIA chatbot uses OpenAI's models on WhatsApp and SMS to coach teachers and caregivers of crisis-affected children in Borno, Adamawa and Yobe. Initial testing found 78% of educators found it intuitive, used 3-4 times weekly.
