Summary

Plan Vivo-certified (PV_2011_006) community reforestation in Bolivia's Cochabamba Tropics. Smallholder farmers plant native mahogany, cedar, and 12 other species on deforested land; CDM AR-AMS0001 permanent-plot monitoring verifies 200–313 tCO₂e/ha over 40 years.
