

Argentina's National Pilot Cuts Judicial Task Times by Up to 90% with Generative AI

Summary

Argentina's Ministry of Justice and SAIJ piloted generative AI across the judiciary: 5,000 court staff rated it 81% positive, and identifying grounds for appeal fell from 25 minutes to 2.5, with jurisprudence searches cut by around 90%.
