

Armenia Tree Project's Community Tree Planting Programme — 30 Years of Urban Reforestation in Yerevan

Summary

Since 1994, Armenia Tree Project has planted 140,067 trees at 384 sites across all 12 districts of Yerevan with municipalities, schools and hospitals, an estimated 27,000 tonnes of CO2 captured over the trees' lifetimes.
