Summary

SAFOD, the University of Washington, Stellenbosch University and Dimagi piloted AT-Info-Map, an offline mobile directory of assistive-technology suppliers, training 352 stakeholders across Botswana, Zambia, Malawi and Lesotho before simplifying the design for sustainability.
