Summary

AACC, APLU and UC Berkeley's Zachary Pardos launched ATAIN in late 2024; its CourseWise AI platform suggests evidence-cited course equivalencies for community-college transfer. A pilot cohort grew to 60 US colleges by April 2025, but no outcome data has been published yet.
