

Audimus — AI Speech Recognition Automates Angola's National Assembly Transcripts

Summary

Since 2017, Angola's National Assembly has used Audimus, an AI speech engine from Portugal's VoiceInteraction, to auto-transcribe plenary audio into the official record. Two independent outlets confirm the deployment, but no timing, accuracy or cost figures are public.
