

Bangladesh's Gender Budget Report — Ministry of Finance Gender-Responsive Budgeting

Summary

Since FY2009-10, Bangladesh's Ministry of Finance has tracked gender-tagged budget allocations, now across 40+ ministries and roughly a third of the national budget, though its own reviewers find allocations are tracked but rarely reprioritised by outcome.
