Summary

A train-the-trainer cascade - 21 WFP partner organisations to community mobilisers - delivered two rounds of mobile-money and digital-literacy training to over 300,000 women under Somalia's national Baxnaano safety net, which had reached over 4 million Somalis by December 2025.
