Summary

Belarus's Ministry of Education has mandated a revised informatics curriculum (Resolution No. 32, 22 July 2026) that integrates AI into all grades 6–9 nationwide from 1 September 2026: 139 hours over four years teaching students to query, verify and critically analyse AI outputs.
