Summary

Belgrade's CEUS and city Environmental Protection Secretariat built the Western Balkans' first Urban Living Lab, ratifying a 60-member, 35-institution Partnership for Urban Innovation under EU CLEVER Cities to co-design a Linear Park on a disused rail corridor.
