Summary

A Qatari public-private partnership installed 1,927 free computer/Wi-Fi facilities in migrant worker housing, distributed 20,000+ refurbished computers, and used volunteers to help ~1.5 million low-wage migrant workers gain basic ICT and online-safety skills.
