Summary

Suriname's Better Prepared Suriname foundation and KU Leuven ran a national responsible-AI teacher-training pilot (March 2026): 180 of a 250-teacher target registered online, followed by hands-on training for 30 selected teachers, backed by the Ministry of Education.
