

BFIT-Bund's Second EU Monitoring Report — Tracking Digital Accessibility Across German Public Bodies

Summary

Germany's federal accessibility monitoring body tested 7,239 public websites and 269 apps in 2022–2024, more than triple the previous cycle — finding not one fully accessible, though accessibility-statement publication rose from 36% to 48%.
