

Bit Alliance — Bosnia and Herzegovina's Diaspora-Driven IT Export Growth

Summary

Bosnia's IT companies, organised through Bit Alliance, helped grow national ICT exports to €260m in 2025 (+17% y/y) largely through private initiative and diaspora ties rather than state strategy, with 40+ member firms reporting €80m combined revenue.
