

BOSCO — Spain's Supreme Court Forces Open the Source Code Behind the Electricity Social Bonus

Spain's BOSCO app decides eligibility for the electricity 'bono social' subsidy; after Civio proved it wrongly denied eligible applicants and the government refused disclosure for 7 years, the Supreme Court ordered its source code opened in Sept 2025.
