Summary

CARNET's ESF+-funded BrAIIn project piloted Croatia's first AI curriculum in VET schools, covering responsible AI use, plagiarism and authorship crediting; 68 teachers and 1,018 students across 53 schools took part, with over 90% of teachers planning to continue in 2025/26.
