

BRISE-Vienna — AI-assisted building permit review for regulatory compliance

AI in the Public Sector · Good practice · Austria

Quality score: 60/100

Evidence strength: Observational / pre–post

Summary

Vienna’s BRISE-Vienna checks BIM building permit submissions against city regulations using AI, cutting processing time by up to 50% (from ~12 to ~6 months). EIPA awarded a Good Practice Certificate in March 2024; replication discussions with other municipalities are ongoing.
