Brunei's Ministry of Education ran nationwide workshops (318 school leaders and teachers, 2024) to disseminate an AI-use toolkit adapted from TeachAI's Seven Principles, then codified a formal GenAI Handbook in 2025 covering data protection, academic integrity and student safeguarda
