Summary

Canada-funded 'Build Back Equal', launched in Saint Lucia in May 2022 by UN Women and UNFPA, drove the country's first-ever National GBV Task Force (Dec 2024) and new protocols, plus skills training and financing for women entrepreneurs in tourism and agriculture.
