Cambridge Enterprise, Cambridge's tech-transfer arm since 2006, disclosed 1,129 inventions, signed 874 licences and formed 20 companies in 2024-25, while the university spun out 26 new companies in 2024 — the biggest single-year rise of the UK's top three.
