Summary

A US\$20.1M World Bank IDA credit financed a fibre network across Nicaragua's Caribbean coast, aiming to connect some 180,000 people, including indigenous and Afro-descendant communities; a 2022 115km segment alone reached a documented 75,262 residents with health-centre and school
