

Cayman Islands Runs a National 'AI Readiness' Teacher Training Ahead of 2026 CXC Assessment Reform

With the Caribbean exam board CXC set to permit AI in school-based assessments from 2026, the Cayman Islands ran a Nov 2025-Feb 2026 'AI Readiness' phase, training teachers on AI basics, exam rules and ethics via UCCI facilitators.
