Summary

Africa's first open innovation hub, founded in Lagos in 2010; by 2025 it had deployed \$17.1 M cumulatively to 3,312 ventures across 49 African countries, unlocking \$170 M in outside investment at a 5:1 leverage ratio, and trained 25,245 people.
