Summary

Built in 8 months after a deadly 2010 landslide, Rio's Centro de Operações e Resiliência (COR) fuses 50+ agencies' data into one 24/7 room. City/EBRD figures report a 30% cut in emergency response time, but the EBRD's own review notes 2020 disasters still took a heavy toll.
