Summary

CFE TEIT has installed 102,000+ free broadband hotspots across rural Mexico using the Federal Electricity Commission's infrastructure, raising rural internet coverage from 41% (2018) to 66% (2024) per INEGI ENDUTIH and adding 6.7 million rural users.
