

Change Starts at Home — Radio & Community Listening Groups Against Intimate Partner Violence, Nepal

Summary

A radio drama and weekly community listening groups run by Equal Access International in Chitwan, Nawalparasi and Kapilvastu, Nepal. A cluster-randomised trial found significant gains on secondary outcomes; primary violence figures were not independently confirmed here.
