

Chidi — AI Learning Companion Piloted Across Rwanda's Civil Service and ALX's Pan-African Learners

Summary

Rwanda's ICT/Education ministries, Anthropic and ALX launched Chidi, a Claude-based Socratic AI tutor, for ~2,000 civil servants/educators and ALX's 200,000+ African learners. Early data (1,100+ chats, 9/10 self-reported satisfaction) is promising but unevaluated.
