Summary

ChileCompra cross-checks officials' asset declarations against suppliers' beneficial owners, flagging conflicts of interest before contracts are awarded. In 2025, flagged cases rose 19.6x to 12,395 and agency corrections rose 18.6x to 3,434, across \$3.9B in reviewed procurement.
