

Chile's Law 21.369 – Preventing and Sanctioning Gender Violence in Higher Education (2021)

Summary

Promulgated August 2021, Chile's Law 21.369 obliges every higher education institution to adopt Gender Protocols on sexual harassment and gender-based violence; by Nov 2022, 96.3% of universities reported comprehensive policies and 100% had all Prevention Model elements in place.
