Founded in 2002 at Poland's oldest university, CITTRU runs Jagiellonian University's tech-transfer pipeline: in 2021 alone it produced 68 knowledge-transfer agreements (incl. 9 licenses) and 19 Polish plus 49 international patent applications, from a 150+ product portfolio.
