Summary

At Dushanbe's AI CONF, Tajikistan's Ministry of Industry agreed with Perplexity AI and Epsilon3.ai to pilot Comet, billed as the first agent-based AI browser for the public sector, training 140 staff in a fall-2025 trial ahead of a possible 2026 rollout — no results yet published
