Summary

Launched July 2023 with €60,000 from Deutsche Bahn Stiftung, Connect@Station equips Münster's Bahnhofsmmission with a self-service PC terminal, loanable phones and tablets, free Wi-Fi and digital-skills courses for the roughly 140 people in poverty or homelessness who visit daily.
